We are applying for a general liquor licence via VCGLR as we will have 3 tables, a couch and 2 stools as "bar seating" for people to come in and have a drink if they like and to buy take away drinks. We will also have wine and beer tastings for locals to get them more familiar with locally owned breweries and wineries in Victoria mainly, but other parts of Australia as well so a licence is needed for that.
